Notes:

One-half credit/semester is given for courses meeting 4 or more class periods per week. .25 credit/semester is given for courses meeting less than 4 class periods per week.

Total credits for graduation are 28. Required courses make up 25.5 of those credits. The remaining elective credits (2.5) may be chosen from subjects listed in *italics*.

A student's GPA is calculated from grades in Humanities, Science, Math, Foreign Languages, Logic and Rhetoric. All other subjects are non-GPA.

A half-credit is required in PE. A one-time credit is given for participation in varsity athletics for a total of 1 credit in PE/Athletics.

In order to graduate from Grace Academy:

1. A student must earn a minimum of 2 credits in a foreign language in grades 10 - 12.
2. A student must have a minimum of 2 credits in a classical language.
3. Math credits must include 2 years of algebra, geometry and pre-calculus as a minimum.
4. Science credits must include integrated physics and chemistry, biology and chemistry as a minimum, with a fourth year of science strongly encouraged.
